

Official Rules and Regulations for WATM ABC 23 Keystone Idol Flyaway Sweepstakes:

1. No purchase necessary. By entering this contest, you agree and understand that your information will be shared with the WATM ABC 23 ("Sponsor") but will not be sold or shared with any other agency.
2. Contestants may enter a total of one time each day during the WATM ABC 23 Keystone Idol Flyaway Sweepstakes. One entry may be submitted per day at abc23.com from Monday 4/8/2019 – Monday 4/22/2019. In order to be selected as the grand prize winner, entrants must meet specifications as outlined in items 3-23 of the official rules and regulations for the WATM ABC 23 Keystone Idol Flyaway Sweepstakes.
3. All Qualified contestants will be entered into the Grand Prize drawing. One winner will be randomly selected and awarded the Grand Prize (Grand Prize includes: a trip to Los Angeles, CA for Winner and one (1) guest ("Guest") to the live American Idol semifinals ("Trip"). Trip includes: two (2) tickets to the live American Idol on Sunday, May 12, 2019 ("Event"); domestic round-trip coach airline transportation for two (2) from the major airport nearest to winner's US residence to Los Angeles, CA; double occupancy hotel accommodations for two (2) nights (one room, room rate and taxes only); escorted ground transportation to the Event; and funds in the amount of one hundred dollars (\$100) for transportation to and from the airport in Los Angeles, CA. – retail value \$1,880.00) provided they continue to meet the specifications as outlined in the rules.
